

Directions (& spots on the way) ...

if you're FLYING IN to the 2019 CSAA conference

Venue: **Claggett Center** (For **GPS**, use 3035 Buckeystown Pike, Adamstown, MD 21710)

From Reagan National Airport (DCA) - just outside Washington DC:

Directions to the Claggett Center: George Washington Parkway NORTH to I-495 Beltway NORTH to I-270 NORTH (LEFT exit off I-495) to URBANA exit #26 MD Rt. 80; end of exit ramp turn LEFT, continue on 80 through circle; 80 ends, turn left on MD Rt. 85; entrance to Claggett Center .2 mi. on LEFT; follow driveway to parking lot.

Along the way...

- Washington, DC (Arlington National Cemetery & Lincoln Memorial are right along your route!)
- Clara Barton House (first exit off Beltway - Clara Barton Parkway, approx. 2 mi.; www.nps.gov/clba) – a teacher at one-room schools early in her career, Clara Barton will make a guest appearance at the conference's Sunday evening welcoming program.

From Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI) - south of Baltimore:

Directions to the Claggett Center: I-195 to I-95 NORTH to I-695 NORTH (LEFT exit off I-95) to I-70 WEST; stay on I-70 approx. 38 mi. to Frederick (*roughly paralleling the first commercial railroad line in the U.S.!*); merge onto I-270 SOUTH; 1.7 mi. to exit #31B MD Rt. 85 SOUTH; stay on 85 8 mi. to entrance to Claggett Center on LEFT; follow driveway to parking lot.

Along the way...

- Brick Ridge Restaurant (Mt. Airy) – housed in 1892 schoolhouse; Sunday brunch 11am-2pm; dinner 4-9 pm; <http://www.brickridge.com>
- New Market – “Maryland’s Antiques Capital” (also numerous antique stores in Frederick, closer to the Claggett Center)

From Dulles International Airport (IAD) - northern Virginia:

Directions to the Claggett Center: Dulles Access Road to VA Rt. 267 WEST (toll); stay on 267 13 mi. to US Rt. 15 NORTH 14 mi. into Maryland; immediately after Potomac River bridge turn RIGHT onto MD Rt. 28; continue 5 mi.; turn LEFT onto MD Rt. 85; continue 4.5 mi.; entrance to Claggett on RIGHT; follow driveway to parking lot.

Along the way...

- In Lucketts VA, along US Rt. 15, notice Town Hall (old wooden 4-room school) on the right after the elementary school; Old Lucketts Store just beyond the traffic light is an antiques emporium extraordinaire housing 3 dozen dealers in a restored general store; www.luckettsstore.com
- Rocky Point Creamery along MD Rt. 28 – local favorite ice cream shop ... *if you need a “fix”!*

Whichever airport is your arrival/departure point, plan to extend your stay in the area and reserve several days to sightsee in Washington, DC, our nation's capital!
