Site visits to 7 gorgeously restored schoolhouses ringing the Finger Lakes via motorcoach

- Schoolhouses range from the oldest cobblestone school building in North America and one used from 1814 to 1931—117 years—to an octagonal school and a “centennial” school, built in 1876
- Includes picnic lunch overlooking picturesque Cazenovia Lake
