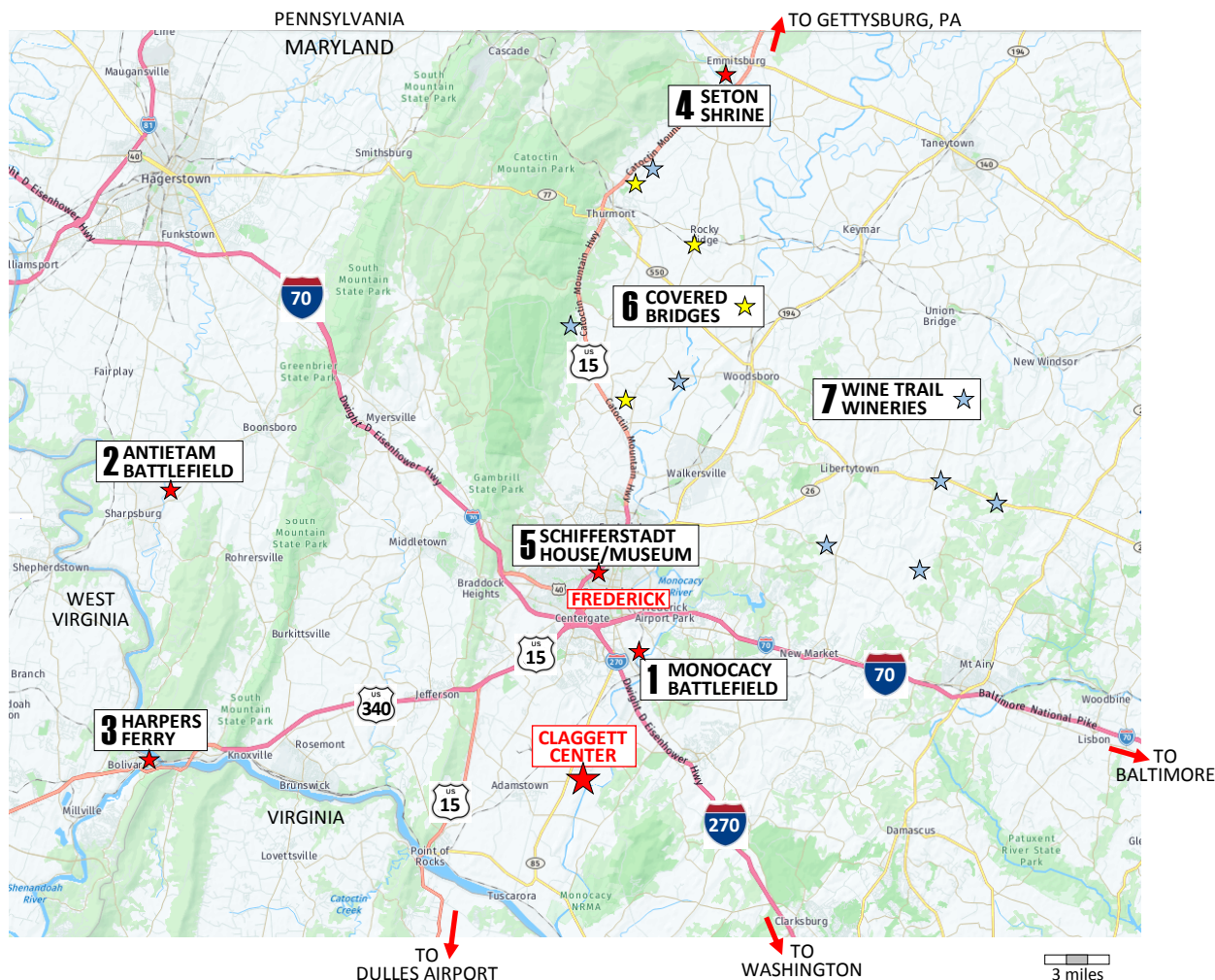


On-Your-Own Sunday (June 16) Driving Excursions



1. Monocacy Battlefield - “the battle that saved Washington”: www.nps.gov/mono
2. Antietam Battlefield - site of the Civil War battle that was the bloodiest day in American history and which led to the issuance of the Emancipation Proclamation: www.nps.gov/anti; one-room schoolhouse nearby (17626 Bakersfield Rd., 3 mi. north on Rt. 65 from Antietam Visitors Center)
3. Harpers Ferry WV - picturesque, completely restored Civil War-era town and site of John Brown’s raid: www.nps.gov/hafe
4. Seton Shrine (Emmitsburg, MD) - commemorating Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first American saint, and site of the first U.S. parochial school for girls that she founded: www.setonshrine.org
5. Schifferstadt - mid-18th century Germanic stone house/museum open 1-4 pm: www.fredericklandmarks.org
