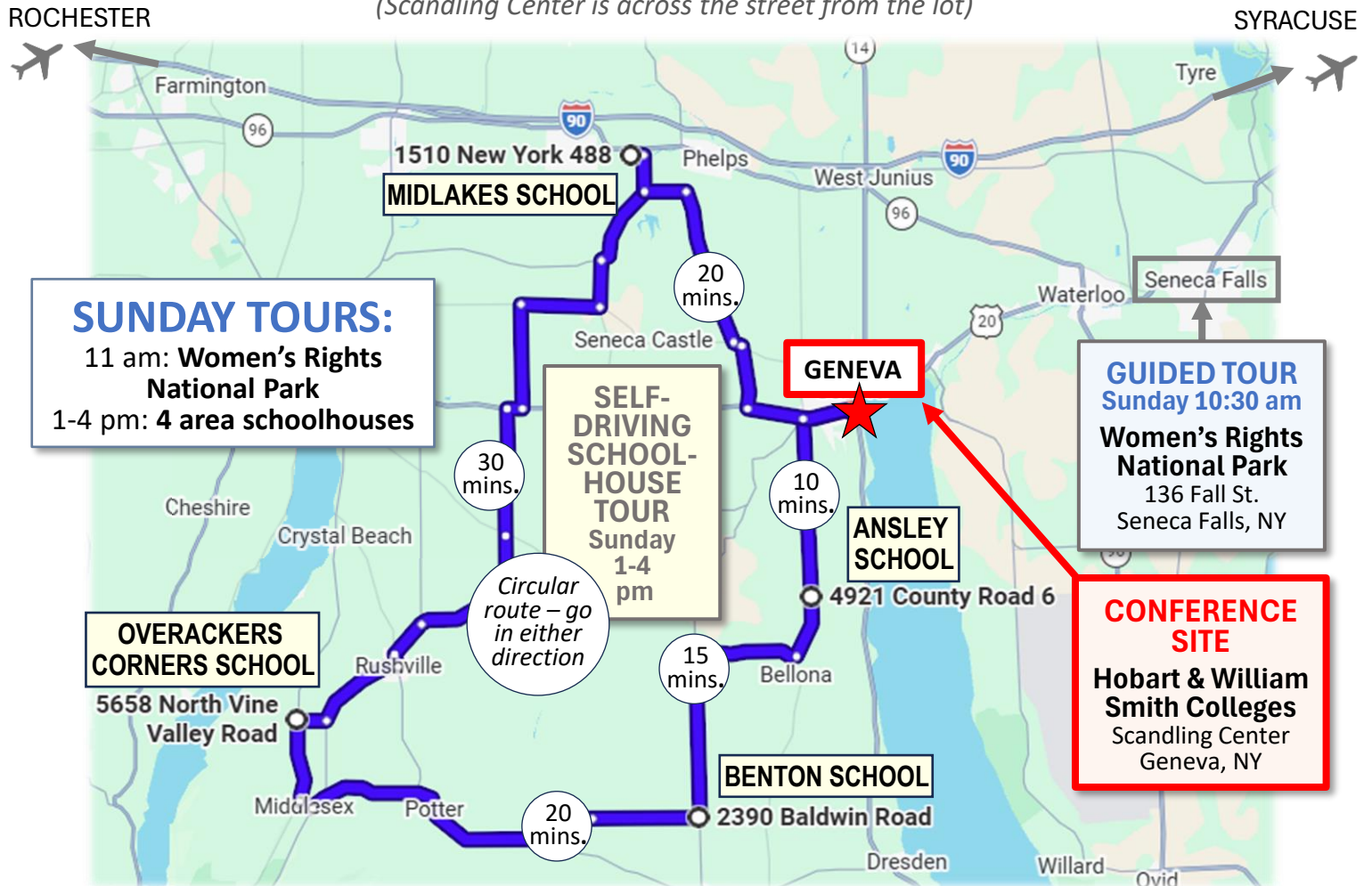

The Women's Rights National Historical Park tells the story of the first Women's Rights Convention, held in nearby Seneca Falls on July 19-20, 1848. Learn about the key 19<sup>th</sup> century reform figures who attended. Hear the words of the Declaration of Sentiments, calling for women to be treated equally, modeled on the Declaration of Independence.

## ANSLEY SCHOOLHOUSE

Built in 1849 on the Ansley family farm and used for more than a century until 1954; returned to the Ansley family and



restored as part of the Town of Geneva Bicentennial celebration in 1976; still on its original site and maintained with the involvement of Ansley family descendants; the closest schoolhouse to our conference locale.

## BENTON SCHOOLHOUSE

Another inspiring community restoration initiative; built in 1864, then donated by its owners and moved to its present site—also donated—from its original location about 2 miles due west; restored over a

10-year period in the 1990s with volunteer labor and donated school items; now maintained by the Town of Benton.

## MIDLAKES SCHOOLHOUSE

Built in 1928 in nearby Manchester and known as the Coonsville School; closed in the mid-1940s when schools were centralized; moved 6 miles next to the current Midlakes Elementary School in 2009; restored over the next year by carpentry students, local businesses and volunteers; a grand reopening ceremony held in May 2010; the bell, from a larger

brick school, arrived just three years ago and was dedicated in 2024.

1510 NY-488, Clifton Springs, NY (enter the Midlakes / Phelps-Clifton Springs School District campus and continue straight to schoolhouse)



## OVERACKERS CORNERS SCHOOLHOUSE



Handsome Italianate-style schoolhouse with distinctive arched windows; built about 1874 and closed in 1938 due to school consolidation; also restored over a 10-year period in the 1990s; original bell and chalkboard present; listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1994. *The school today looks nearly identical to the photo at right which appeared in National Geographic magazine in 1933.*
